Moscato D'Asti

23

Umberto Fiore – Piedmont, Italy

Pale straw yellow. Heady perfume of fresh vine flower, peach and tropical fruits. Gently sweet, with restrained alcohol, the vibrant fruit flavours envelop the palate, underscored by a refreshing acidity.

Cipriani Bellini

Cipriani – Veneto, Italy

Invented at the famous Cipriani Harry's Bar in Venice, the original Bellini Cipriani is the ultimate summer apéritif, a mixture of Mediterranean white peach juice and sparkling Prosecco Cipriani.

Piedmont – Italy

This Prosecco shows fine and generous bubbles and a light straw yellow colour. The nose has aromas of green apple while the palate is off dry with a floral character of neroli and a fruity character of peach which is supported by a medium intense body.

Cassar de Malte

Malta D.O.K – Marsovin, Malta

Cassar de Malte owes its unique character and elegant finesse to the Chardonnay grapes of the Wardija Valley Estate and also to the slow, cool second fermentation in bottle and long maturation on the lees for a minimum of 12 months prior to disgorgement. The Bouquet is complex with rich notes of toasted bread, honey, citrus fruits and lingering floral notes whilst its good level of acidity fine natural sparkle and creamy mousse make it invitingly rich and full in taste.

Cipriani – Veneto, Italy

With its flowery, fruity bouquet and its fresh, light flavour full of verve, Cipriani's Prosecco wine DOC is the ultimate simple but sophisticated wine which personifies the unique Italian lifestyle.





CHAMPAGNE

Moët & Chandon Imperial 90

Brut – France

Golden straw yellow with green highlights. The delicious sumptuousness of white-fleshed fruits (pear, peach, apple). The alluring caress of fine bubbles. The soft vivacity of citrus fruit and nuances of gooseberry.

Moët & Chandon Imperial Rosé 100

Brut – France

Spontaneous, radiant, romantic expression of the Moët & Chandon style, a style distinguished by its bright fruitiness, its seductive palate and its elegant maturity. Pink with amber highlights.

Veuve Clicquot 115

Brut – France

The Veuve Clicquot vineyard is comprised of 47% Chardonnay grapes, 36% Pinot Noir and 17% Pinot Meunier. The Clicquot vines are mostly situated on gentle sloping hills allowing the vines to benefit from shallow soil and a maximum exposure to sunlight.

Dom Perignon vintage 2010 230

Champagne – France

Dom is always a blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. In its youth, it is smooth, creamy and balanced with lots of fruit. With time, it develops toasty mushroomy aromas and layers of complexity. It really is an impressive Champagne.

LOCAL WHITE WINES

Isis Chardonnay 34

Malta D.O.K – Meridiana, Malta

A dry, brilliant, straw-yellow colour with a pale green rim; a fresh, complex bouquet of grapefruit and other exotic white fruits with gentle floral notes; and a well-structured, citrus taste with a long, pleasantly acidic, aftertaste.

1919 Chardonnay / Moscato / Girgentina 26

Malta D.O.K – Meridiana, Malta

A dry, rounded white wine of character with fruity aromas of apples, limes and a floral hint of orange blossom developing some nutty buttery undertones with time. On the palate, it is very smooth with ripe citrus flavours and an elegant long finish.

Ulysses Chardonnay / Chenin Blanc 25

Gozo D.O.K – Marsovin, Malta

Produced entirely from hand-picked grapes harvested in family owned vineyards in Gozo, this medium bodied dry white wine has a pale lemon bright colour, aromas and flavours of a citrus and stone fruit character of lemons, limes and peaches. It has a refreshing acidity that perfectly balances its intense fruit flavours.

Antonin Blanc 36

D.O.K. GOZO – Marsovin, Gozo

A white wine with aromas of vanilla and burnt toast giving way to crisp citrus and apple notes on the palate. It is full and round in the mouth and whilst retaining a fruity Chardonnay character, the subtle nuance of oak adds finesse and complexity.

Caravaggio Chenin Blanc 22

Malta D.O.K – Marsovin, Malta

A dry, medium bodied white wine. Stone fruit flavours of peaches, apricots and pears that may develop some savoury buttery notes in time. To be enjoyed on its own and with salads, fish, poultry, veal and pork.

Palatino Sauvignon Blanc 19

Malta D.O.K – Camilleri Wines, Malta

Generous notes of exotic fruits and lychees greet the nose of this locally-grown Sauvignon Blanc with light grassy nuances. Its medium-bodied palate is elegant yet powerful, making this an ideal match with seafood and shellfish whilst providing excellent company on its own.

Laurenti Vermentino 30

Malta D.O.K – Camilleri Wines, Malta

Cuvée Selection is the concept behind this wine, where the very best Vermentino grapes have been selected from this vintage to produce a wine with intense aromas of orchard fruit: ripe peaches, pears and tropical fruits of pineapple and lychee. The palate is zesty, medium bodied and fruit driven but underlined by a light mineral savoury note. It is refreshing, complex and has a long lingering finish.

LOCAL RED WINES

Antonin Noir 35

Malta D.O.K – Meridiana, Malta

Antonin is a blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc grapes. All harvested from the Marnisi vineyard in Marsaxlokk. Merlot being the dominant grape variety in this wine. Low yields, barrel ageing and judicious blending produce a concentrated full bodied wine with very good ageing potential. Excellent grape maturity and its unique fruit driven character makes it very enjoyable, even in its early years.

Palatino Merlot 22

Malta D.O.K – Camilleri Wines, Malta

Full bodied red wine with plenty of ripe black fruit aromas of forest berries and plums underlined by some subtle dark chocolate notes. A generous wine with ample smooth tannins on the palate and a very pleasant long finish.





Marnisi Organic 37

Malta D.O.K – Marsovin, Malta

The 8.5 ha Marnisi Estate is situated near Marsaxlokk in the South of Malta. Marnisi is a blend representative of the 3 grape varieties on this Estate made from 100% organically grown grapes which include Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and smaller quantities of Cabernet Franc. This wine has a deep colour intensity, aromas and flavours of a black fruit character with complex hints of leather, smoke and spice. Twelve months ageing in French oak barrels give it a velvety finish on the palate and excellent ageing potential.

Ulysses Shiraz - Cabernet Sauvignon – Merlot 26

Gozo D.O.K – Marsovin, Malta

Produced entirely from handpicked grapes harvested in family owned vineyards in Gozo, this full bodied red wine has an intense black fruit aroma underlined by a distinctive mineral and vegetal character. On the palate it has ample tannins and flavours reminiscent of blackcurrants, blueberries and a hint of roast peppery spice.

1919 Ġellewża 26

Malta D.O.K – Marsovin, Malta

Complex, full bodied red wine with intense ripe fruit aromas of forest berries, amarena cherries and figs underlined by distinct notes of peppery, sweet spice and a hint of fresh tobacco. On the palate it is very smooth with plenty of ripe, velvety tannins and a very pleasant, long lingering finish.

Caravaggio Shiraz 22

Malta D.O.K – Marsovin, Malta

Dry, full-bodied. Black fruit aromas of mulberries and ripe plums with distinctive notes of black olives and some peppery spicy undertones. On the palate it is well structured and robust with ample tannins and an enjoyable long finish.

ROSÉ WINES

Odyssey Shiraz - Grenache Rosé 25

Gozo D.O.K – Marsovin, Malta

This fine and fruity Rosé has an intense aroma reminiscent of raspberries, strawberries and apples. It is off-dry, medium bodied and is best served lightly chilled accompanying fish, veal, pork and poultry dishes.

Rosé D’Anjou 22

Les Gardelles – Loire Valley, France

This Rosé wine shows a lively pinkish colour, the nose shows characteristics of strawberry and cherries. The palate is medium dry and supported with lively red fruit character like strawberries and red cherries finishing with a long cleansing finish.

Zinfandel Rosé 21

Eagle Creek – California, USA

This Rosé wine shows a pale pink rose colour, on the nose it has a red fruit character of strawberries. The palate is medium sweet with an intense fruit character of red cherry, cranberry and pomegranate.

ITALIAN WHITE WINES

Gavi 22

Umberto Fiore – Piedmont, Italy

A fresh, harmonious white, followed by apple, peach and chive flavours. Lingers with a clean aftertaste of mountain water and minerality.

Greco di Tufo 32

Cantina Vadiaperti – Avellino, Campania

Classic Greco with elegant refined notes of ripe fruit, golden delicious apples lifted by floral and acacia honey nuances. The palate is fresh and structured with good balance and length and a perceptible bitter almond finish.

Gavi di Gavi 32

Villa Sparina – Piedmont, Italy

Bright yellow colour, delicate bouquet of flowers and fruit with a scent of peach. Full and rich flavour, the complete grape-ripening gives a wine which is soft on the palate with a fine aromatic flavour at the end.

Pecorino Avalos 32

Ilauri – Abruzzo, Italy

Ripe with sherbety notes, notes of fresh lime and mango. It is a fruity ripe style with a round mellow palate but enough zesty acidity to balance it.

Müller Thurgau 29

St. Micheal-Eppan – Alto Adige, Italy

This well-known German grape variety is particularly well suited to high-altitude vineyards and therefore thrives at elevations above 600 meters. Müller-Thurgau is appreciated for its fresh fruit, delicate notes of hay and light nutmeg, and subdued acidity.

Pinot Grigio 27

St. Micheal-Eppan – Alto Adige, Italy

Straw yellow colour with light greenish shades, to the nose it proposes fresh fruit perfumes with floral notes. To the palate pleasantly fresh, tasty and persistent.

Lighea 33

Donnafugata Zibibbo – Sicily, Italy

Bright straw yellow color with greenish hues. The nose offers a rich and fragrant bouquet where the classic notes of orange blossom are combined with citrus hints (cedar and bergamot) and exotic fruit (lychee). On the palate the fruity and floral notes resurface accompanied by a marked freshness, with good persistence and a pleasant mineral finish.

ITALIAN RED WINES

Barbera D'Asti 23

Umberto Fiore – Piedmont, Italy

It is a long-lasting wine maintaining the fresh colour of its variety: full-body, intense ruby red colour with garnet nuances and harmonious tannins. It reminds of black cherries, raspberries, candied apple, white pepper, prunes and blonde tobacco.





Valpolicella Classico 26
Speri – Veneto, Italy
The colour is a ruby red with violet tones. On the palate it shows characteristics of cherries and black forest fruits which are supported by medium intensity. Ideal with most Mediterranean food it could also be drunk on its own.

Piccini Chianti Riserva 24
Piccini – Tuscany, Italy
Intense, dark ruby colour. Potent, luscious and velvety, with notes of blackberry and raspberry fruit. It shows perfect ripeness and balance. Savoury, spicy finish in oak frame.

Gran Passione Rosso “Apassimento” 25
Fossalta Di Piave – Veneto, Italy
Intense purple colour, tending towards amber with ageing. The subsequent oak ageing gives the pleasant notes of spices and vanilla. This wine has a very solid structure due to the elevated alcohol and the balance between soft tannins and acidity.

Sassirossi Primitivo di Manduria 32
Feudi Salentini – Puglia, Italy
Sassirossi Primitivo di Manduria is a full-bodied wine. It has an intense red colour with garnet hints and a bouquet resulting from the perfect harmony between spicy and balsamic notes and ripe red fruit. Its intense taste is enriched by ripe tannins that leave a touch of black pepper on the tip of your tongue.

Sedara 33
Donnafugata – Sicily, Italy
Ruby red in color with purple hues, offers a fruity bouquet with hints of red fruit (cherry and plum) and spices (black pepper) combined with a light balsamic note of mint. On the palate it shows a good structure with soft tannins and a pleasant freshness. A pleasant red, versatile in food matching, perfect for every day.

FRENCH WHITE WINES

Sancerre Grandmontains 36
Domaine Laporte – Loire Valley, France
Nice ripe fruity nose with a distinctive grassiness and subtle gooseberry notes that are characteristic of Sauvignon. Quite perfumed and nicely balanced, somewhere in between the old-world and new-world styles.

Pouilly Fumé ‘Les Duchesses’ 38
Domaine Laporte – Loire Valley, France
This wine shows a pale straw yellow colour. On the nose it has intense aromas of grapefruit and white flowers while on the palate it is light to medium bodied with a crisp acidity, bright citrus flavours and flinty minerality.

Chablis 40
Louis Latour – Burgundy, France
This Chablis has a lovely pale golden colour. The nose is floral with a fresh palate and pleasant notes of citrus. A nice minerality on the finish.



Côtes du Rhône Blanc

Clos Des Miran – Rhône Valley, France

A bright, golden colour on first look. A fresh note aromas of white flowers, apricot, acacia and white peach. The fruits come through on the palate, with plenty of richness and body. A well-rounded wine with elegance, power and balance.

FRENCH RED WINES

Côtes du Rhône

Clos Des Miran – Rhône Valley, France

Clear ruby wine with overtones of red berry fruits with a round and supple palate with smooth aftertaste. This wine is endowed with an excellent aromatic balance.

SPANISH WHITE WINE

Verdejo Rueda Blanco

24

Marqués De Cáceres – Rueda, Spain

A hugely aromatic wine expressing intense flavours of apples and pears with a light floral background. On the palate, it has a freshness and vivacity that comes through with an additional handful of lavish fruit.

SPANISH RED WINE

Rioja Crianza

Marqués De Cáceres – Rioja, Spain

A lively bouquet with notes of red fruit that add a pleasant freshness softened by a discreet touch of vanilla. Deliciously full in the mouth where well-integrated, silky tannins highlight the wine's fruit.

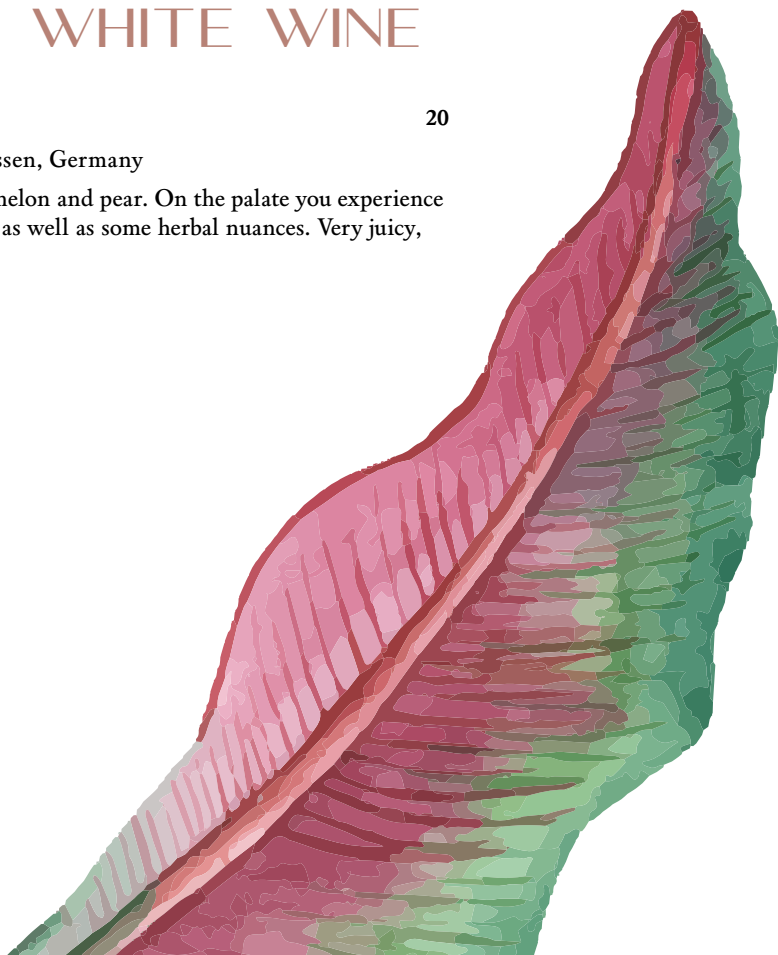
GERMAN WHITE WINE

Liebfraumilch

Johann Bihn – Rheinhessen, Germany

Inviting scent of honey melon and pear. On the palate you experience aromas of apple and pear as well as some herbal nuances. Very juicy, crisp and delicate wine.



NEW WORLD WINES

Catena Chardonnay 26

Bodega Nicolas Catena – Mendoza, Argentina

The Catena Chardonnay combines the unique expressions of two high altitude Catena estate vineyards. The Agrelo vineyard offers honeyed stone fruit flavours with a rich, unctuous mouthfeel, while the Tupungato vineyard lends citrus notes, pear and fig flavours with a strong minerality and a crisp finish.

Mount Nelson Sauvignon Blanc 35

Marlborough, New Zealand

Clear and bright with pale green and straw highlights. Gooseberry and passion fruit aromas with freshly cut grass notes and a faint undercurrent of citrus blossom. Concentrated and intense, the wine shows gooseberry, passion fruit and stone-fruit flavours with a hint of lime.

Chenin Blanc 23

Leopard's Leap – Cape, South Africa

This Chenin Blanc shows earthiness and abundance of fruit supported by with layers of ripe tropical fruit and nutty undertones combined with a zesty freshness. Exceptionally versatile it compliments soups seafood, white meats and salads.

Pinotage – Shiraz 23

Leopard's Leap – Cape, South Africa

This wine has a medium bodied intensity and soft integrated tannins, its characteristics reflects the distinctive style of both varietals in the blend. On the palate it features fruit characteristics like plum and mulberry which are supported by vanilla undertones with a hint of spice and white pepper.

Catena Malbec 32

Bodega Nicolas Catena – Mendoza, Argentina

This wine has the typical deep, dark violet colour of Argentine Malbec. The nose offers powerful aromas of black stone fruit interwoven with notes of chocolate and sweet spice from light oak ageing. Flavours of blackberries and blackcurrants lead into a long lingering finish with ripe, velvety tannins.

120 Carménère 22

Santa Rita – Chile

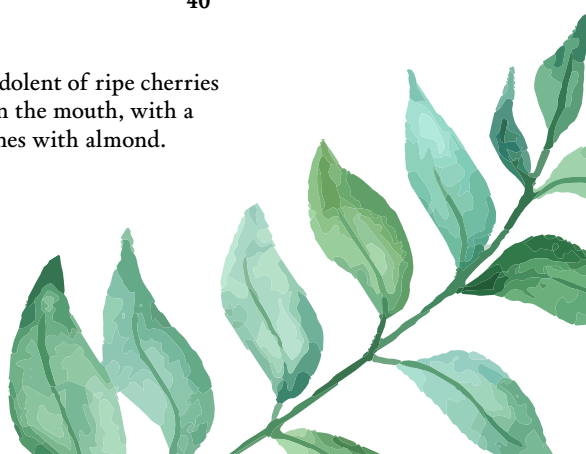
Chile's very own variety offers rich aromas of ripe, red fruit and fragrant spices. On the palate, it is a fresh, light bodied and elegant wine with a commanding, fruity and lingering finish.

PREMIUM WINES

Barbera D'Asti "Montebruna" 40

Braida – Piedmont, Italy

Ruby red-violet colour, a striking aroma, quite redolent of ripe cherries and red berries. It is deep, full and harmonious in the mouth, with a long finish that maintains lasting taste and finishes with almond.

Speri – Veneto, Italy

Intense garnet red, typical nose of dried grapes, concentrated and full flavoured. Dry on the palate, strong but soft and balanced. This wine would accompany very well hearty red meat dishes, game dishes and important cheeses.

Moscato D'Asti 'Vigna Senza Nome'

Braida – Piedmont, Italy

Bright straw yellow, nice foam and rich perlage. An extraordinarily fresh bouquet, and quite varied; from among the many notes one can distinguish fresh fruit, orange blossoms, rose and musk. An elegantly sweet wine with aromatic characteristics of Muscat grape supported by a refreshing acidity and a long finish.

Barolo

Manfredi – Piedmont, Italy

This Barolo shows a tawny colour, on the nose it has aromas of dark cherry fruit, cardamom and celery seed. The palate is dry with strong tannins and intense characteristics of mushrooms, dry leaves and savoury, finishing off with a long length.

Châteauneuf du Pape

65

Château Cabrières – Rhône Valley, France

A most satisfying robust fruity wine with lots of aromas ranging from fresh fruit to green undergrowth. Its full palate closes off with a smooth, long finish.

B&G Côtes de Provence

33

Rose – Provence, France

An explosion of fruit. Expressive on the palate with a nice freshness throughout the finish. Seductive and delicate with ripe red berries and white flowers on the first & second nose! As the famous pink gemstone 'Tourmaline, this unique flask cradles our jewel Grenache [50%], Cinsault [35%] & Syrah [15%].

DESSERT WINES

Dolce Vita – Late Harvest

Malta D.O.K – Camilleri Wines, Malta

This late harvested blend of very ripe Viognier grapes grown in Malta offers enticing, concentrated fruity aromas of peaches and apricots with some underlying notes of stewed apples, honey and melons. Its soft, seductive sweetness and balanced acidity reinforces an explosion of ripe stone fruit flavours on the palate.

Nachtgold "Beerenauslese"

Malta D.O.K – Rheinhessen, Germany

A few months after bottling, this wine presents itself golden, racy and opulent of fruity aromas reminiscent of peaches and citrus fruits. A zesty interaction of finest sweetness and a finely diversified natural acidity.
